



The Art of Machine Quilting

Two Day Class

Supply List

This class will teach the confident beginner to intermediate machine quilter how to decide on a quilting design, quilting a design motif, and free motion quilting. We will focus most of our attention on free motion quilting.

Fabric Requirements:

You will need two pieces of fabric (ones that are NOT pieced) that measure approximately 35-40" square. Choose a solid or tone-on-tone fabric for both pieces; however the fabrics do not need to be the same on both sides. Choose a low loft cotton batting. Hobbs Heirloom 100% cotton or the 80% cotton, 20% polyester blend are good choices. We will be putting the quilt sandwich together in class.

Supplies:

- Sewing Machine in good working order – a must!
- Extension table for your sewing machine (if you have one)
- Darning or free motion quilting foot that fits your sewing machine.
- Sewing machine needles – Sharps 70/10 or 80/12 and Jeans 80/12 (for metallic thread) are good choices. Topstitch or Quilting needles also ok.
- Golden Threads quilting paper to transfer design (very lightweight tissue paper also works).
- Quilt Basting Spray
- Masking Tape (please – NOT blue painter's tape)
- Paper and fabric scissors
- Approximately 200 Size 1 Safety Pins
- Marking pencils that you can see on your fabric.
- A variety of quilting threads that do NOT match your fabric:
 - Metallic
 - Rayon thread
 - Trilobal Polyester thread
 - High quality cotton quilting threads in a variety of weights
