



# Honu Orchid



## Supply List

Honu Orchid is an original two-sided contemporary fiber art design for the confident beginner to intermediate quilter designed by Barbara Shapel.

### **Fabric Requirements:**

#### Orchid Side:

- There are six major petals on the orchid that will require  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard of fabric.
- A fat quarter of light and dark fabric for the throat of the flower.
- $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of fabric to make the 12 leaves.
- 39" square piece of fabric for the background.

#### Honu (Turtle) Side:

- 15" square piece of fabric for the turtle shell.
- $\frac{1}{2}$  yard fabric for the other turtle body parts.
- $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of fabric for the 12 leaves.
- 39" square piece of fabric for the background.
- A piece of batting 40" square.
- $\frac{1}{2}$  yard fabric for the binding and hanging sleeve or tabs.

### **Supplies:**

- \$16 Honu Orchid Contemporary Appliqué Pattern
- Heavy Duty Freezer Paper (available at most grocery stores)
- Thread: Invisible Thread in Smoke or Clear  
Cotton Thread that blends with your Currents color palette  
Water Soluble Thread (optional)
- Iron, Ironing Pad, Spray Starch
- Sewing Machine
- Basic Sewing Supplies
- Scissors to cut paper and fabric
- Value Finder (a red or green viewer to determine fabric value – Optional)
