Supply List

Mandala is an original contemporary fiber art design for the confident beginner to intermediate quilter designed by Barbara Shapel.

Fabric Requirements:

- There are a total of 25 pieces that make up the Mandala circle. The pieces on the outside of the circle measure approximately 5" x 23". This is a great project to use all your scraps on because the more variety of fabric you have, the more interesting the piece will turn out.
- 44" square piece of material for the background fabric.
- 46" square piece of material for the backing of the quilt
- 48" square piece of batting
- 39" round piece of feature fabric for the back of the piece (Optional)

Supplies:

- \$16 Mandala Contemporary Appliqué Pattern
- Heavy Duty Freezer Paper (available at most grocery stores)
- Thread: Invisible Thread in Smoke or Clear
Cotton Thread that blends with your Currents color palette
Water Soluble Thread (optional)
- Iron, Ironing Pad, Spray Starch
- Sewing Machine
- Basic Sewing Supplies
- Scissors to cut paper and fabric
- Yardstick Compass for creating a perfect circle
- Value Finder (a red or green viewer to determine fabric value – Optional)
